I'm going to run through some items worth noting that have taken place in the past year or that we are planning on this coming year.

BENCHES

I know we have talked about installing benches for a long time now, but we were holding out for funds coming from the Province and now that we have those, we are moving forward with the installation of 5 new benches. Todd Dupius has been working on this and we think they will look great on the property. Beth has secured 5 'earth anchors' so hopefully we can prevent theft.

FENCING

DNS will be installing our new fence for the off leash zone and as we have stated in the past, this fence is to provide a break between the on leash and off leash areas. Other sections will be delineated simply by hedgerows and water. It's important for users to understand that this off leash area is not meant to be COMPLETELY enclosed.

PARKING LOT

While we are very aware of the condition of the parking lot located off of Regis Duffy, we have been waiting for the Department of Transportation to repair it. That parking lot installation was initially part of the Bypass Project agreement and it clearly was not done well initially. The last repair they did was great, but just not extensive enough. Hopefully they will get those potholes repaired soon.

TRAILS

Albert Flavel, who did the trails at Bonshaw Provincial park, will begin working on trails this coming weekend. We are doing the trails in three stages. First up is the off leash zone, followed by the remainder of the north side of the property and finally the south side of the property. We are looking for volunteers to help. It is hard labor! The work will start next week and we need 2 people per shift. Morning and afternoon, Saturday and Sunday.
